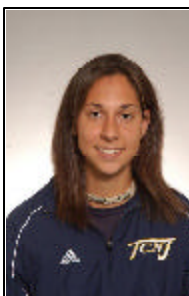

Lions suffer pair of setbacks; remain in playoff hunt

It was a tough week for The College of New Jersey cagers as they battled 22nd Stevens Institute of Technology in Packer Hall before, to the Ducks, 63-52, in a non-conference match-up. The Lions then returned to New Jersey Athletic Conference play and dropped a 74-60 decision at Ramapo College.

Against Stevens, the Lions trailed by only five points at the break, but the Ducks were able to add to that advantage and not allow the hosts to get any closer than eight points in the final five minutes to pull out the win.

Junior **Jeff Molinelli (Pennington, NJ/Hopewell Valley)** led the Lions with a career-high 24 points as he shot 10-of-16 from the floor. Senior **Mark Aziz (Hackettstown, NJ/West Morris)** just missed a double-double as he netted 11 points and pulled down eight rebounds. With those eight rebounds, he surpassed 300 for his career.

A trio of Lions scored in double figures at Ramapo, as Aziz led the team with 16 points and added a team-high eight rebounds. Molinelli and sophomore **Jay Frank (Brick, NJ/Brick Memorial)** contributed with 12 points and six rebounds each.

The race for the final playoff spot in the NJAC South Division heats up for the Lions this week as they play two division opponents. TCNJ starts with a home game against Kean on Wednesday and then play at Richard Stockton College on Saturday. Earlier this season, the Lions posted a 65-63 victory at Kean, while falling to the Ospreys in Packer Hall. The Lions, however, have played well on the road against conference teams with a 2-3 record.

Lion Bites...

- Aziz tops the Lions in scoring this season averaging 14.1 points a game and ranking eighth in the conference. The senior is also in the top 10 in rebounding, grabbing 5.6 boards a contest. Those aren't the only categories he ranks in as he is tied for fourth in blocked shots (1.14 bpg), 12th in field-goal percentage (47.9%) and 10th in free-throw percentage (74.1%). He has been the team's top scorer on nine occasions this season.
- Frank ranks in the top 20 in the NJAC in scoring sitting 18th averaging 11.5 points per game. The sophomore sharpshooter is third in the conference in shooting from behind the 3-point arc, knocking down 44.4 percent of his shots from long range. He has made 32-of-72 attempts.
- Molinelli is third on the team in scoring at 10.1 points per game with senior **Jeff Warner (Jackson, NJ/Jackson)** next at 9.7 points. Warner also leads the team in rebounding (6.9 rpg) and assists (2.48 apg) ranking fifth and 10th, respectively, in the NJAC.
- Senior **Corey Gilmore (South Plainfield, NJ/South Plainfield)** has been a steady performer chipping in with 7.5 points game, 3.0 rebounds and 2.5 assists.
- The Lions have had plenty of balance from 3-point range as Frank leads the team with 32 followed by Warner with 31 and Molinelli with 30. Aziz has chipped in with 12. TCNJ is fourth in the conference in 3-points made with 136.
- Molinelli has already set career highs for points in a season (212), rebounds (100) and assists (41).

TCNJ wins easily in lone game of the week

The Lions took the court only once last week and made quick work of host Ramapo College as nine different players scored in a 74-39 win.

Junior **Hillary Klimowicz (Scotch Plains, NJ/Scotch Plains-Fanwood)** tied a career high with 23 points to lead the Lions with freshman **Kelsey Kutch (Hillsborough, NJ/Hillsborough)** adding 10. Senior **Sara Best (High Bridge, NJ/Voorhees)** and junior **Alyssa Michella (Washington Twp., NJ/Immaculate Heart Academy)** each added nine points with sophomore **Alex Gregorek (Mahway, NJ/Academy of Holy Angels)** chipping in with eight.

Defense has played a big part during TCNJ's modest three-game win streak as they have allowed only 36.3 points per game and held the opponents to under 24 percent shooting from the floor in each of those wins.

TCNJ has an important week ahead hosting sixth-ranked Kean University on Wednesday and then heading to Richard Stockton on Saturday. Kean is currently in first place in the NJAC South Division with a mark of 9-1, while the Lions are second at 7-2. Richard Stockton is challenging for a playoff spot, as they are in fourth place with a conference mark of 4-6.

Lion Bites...

- Klimowicz has posted 16 double-doubles this season and ranks second in the NJAC in scoring and third in rebounding. She leads the team in both categories scoring at a clip of 16.4 points per game and grabbing 11.0 rebounds. She also leads the conference in field-goal percentage at 64.6% (146-for-226) and blocked shots (84). The junior was also named CoSIDA's *ESPN The Magazine* Academic All-America All-District II Third Team.
- Balanced scoring continues to be a key for the Lions with three players scoring in double figures. In addition to Klimowicz, Best (10.7 ppg) and Kutch (10.0 ppg) are each scoring in double digits, followed closely by Gregorek (9.5 ppg).
- Gregorek and Kutch also rank among the conference leaders in field-goal percentage with Gregorek fifth at 50.6% and Kutch in the sixth slot at 50.3%.
- Michella ranks eighth in the NJAC in 3-point field-goal percentage as she has made 30-of-105 from behind the arc. The junior is having a steady season for the Lions, averaging 6.9 points and 5.5 rebounds.
- TCNJ's defense ranks second in the NJAC in points against, allowing only 53.5 points per game. The Lions are the best in the conference in opponents' field goal percentage against, limiting them to only 32.3 percent.

TCNJ performs well at Valentine Invitational

Competing in one of their largest invitationals of the indoor season, the Lions shined meeting several NCAA times in addition to a host of ECAC qualifying marks at the Valentine Invitational hosted by Boston University.

Women's Highlights...

Junior **Stephanie Herrick (Wayne, NJ/Wayne Valley)** finished second in the 800 meters as the returning All-American boasted a NCAA automatic time of 2:11.78. Classmate **Martine McGrath (West Long Branch, NJ/Shore Regional)** earned a NCAA provisional mark in the 5,000 meters as the junior finished fourth with a clocking of 17:28.77. Herrick's event was one of the biggest races of the event with 141 competitors.

TCNJ's women's distance medley relay team boasted a NCAA provisional mark with a time of 11:54.64 as Herrick, freshman **Rochelle Prevard (Sicklerville, NJ/Winslow Twp.)**, freshman **Meryl Wimberly**

(Farmingdale, NJ/Colts Neck) and McGrath ran the event for the Lions.

Junior **Kristen Tricocci (Cinnaminson, NJ/Cinnaminson)** advanced to the finals in the long jump and placed in the top 10 as she had an ECAC worthy leap of 5.34 meters.

In the 500 meters, the Lions had a pair of runners earn ECAC time, as **Jianna Spadaccini (Butler, NJ/Butler)** had a time of 1:19.65 and **Meghan Miller (Sayreville, NJ/Sayreville War Memorial)** finished in 1:21.78.

Senior **Jessica Bonelli (Sewell, NJ/Gloucester Catholic)** finished the 400 meters in 59.31 seconds, while freshman **Meryl Wimberly (Farmingdale, NJ/Colts Neck)** had a time of 2:19.59 in the 800 meters as both runners met ECAC standards.

In the weight throw, sophomore **Ashley Krauss (Flemington, NJ/Hunterdon Central)** had an ECAC toss of 13.07 meters.

The final ECAC standard for TCNJ came in the 4x400 relay as Tricocci, Bonelli, Spadaccini, and Miller combined for a time of 4:00.96.

Men's Highlights...

TCNJ's men's distance medley relay team picked up a NCAA provisional time. The team of freshman **Dennie Waite (Little Silver, NJ/Red Bank Regional)**, sophomore **DeShard Stevens (Jersey City, NJ/James T. Ferris)**, senior **Josh Krowicki (Hilltop, NJ/Triton)** and senior **Galen Johnson (South Plainfield, NJ/South Plainfield)** finished with a time of 10:06.52.

TCNJ excelled in a pair of events with three runners qualifying for the ECAC Championships in the 400 meters and two more in the 800. In the 400, junior **Rob McGowan (Monroe Twp., NJ/Monroe Township)** led the way placing 22nd overall with a time of 49.26 seconds and was followed closely by freshmen **Kyle Gilroy (Oak Ridge, NJ/West Milford Twp.)** with a time of 50.53 and **Jule Brooks (Atlantic City, NJ/Atlantic City)** at 50.70.

Junior **Pasquale DiGioacchino (Bernardsville, NJ/Bernards)** had a qualifying time of 1:54.85 in the 800 meters, with senior **Josh Krowicki (Hilltop, NJ/Triton)** finishing with a time of 1:57.90.

Sophomore **DeShard Stevens (Jersey City, NJ/James T. Ferris)** placed 11th in the 500 meters with an ECAC worthy time of 1:05.32, while junior **Chris Guerriero (Saddle Brook, NJ/Saddle Brook)** also met an ECAC standard in the 5,000 with a clocking of 14:55.80.

TCNJ also had an ECAC time in the 4x400 as Brooks, **Steve Murray (East Windsor, NJ/Hightstown)**, Gilroy and McGowan combined for a time of 3:21.21.

Lions end regular season with two more victories

The Lions capped the regular season with two more dual meet wins as they bested both the University of Scranton and Oswego State.

TCNJ started with a 26-13 victory over Oswego State and then handled Scranton, 53-0. Those two victories pushed TCNJ's winning streak to nine straight and they cap the year with a 19-3 record.

Against Oswego, the Lions took charge early winning by pin in the first two weight classes as freshman **Dan Hughes (Delran, NJ/Delran)** won by fall at 125 and senior **Ray Sarinelli (Rockaway, NJ/Morris Hills)** followed with another at 133.

After the Lakers recorded a win at 141, TCNJ reeled off five straight wins by decision to take a commanding 26-4 lead. Oswego won at 197 and 285 making the final 26-13.

The Lions dominated the host Royals as they recorded their second shutout of the season. Sophomore **Danny Franke (Jackson, NJ/Freehold)** opened the dual meet with a pin in 2:00 at 125 and was the first of four for TCNJ in the win. The other pins were turned in by freshman **Joe Bozzomo (Middlesex, NJ/Middlesex)** at 184, freshman **Mike Denver (Bayville, NJ/Central Regional)** at 197 and senior **Steve Carbone (Cranford, NJ/Cranford)** at 285.

TCNJ also won three matches by technical fall with junior **John Dinan (Nutley, NJ/Nutley)** winning 17-1 at 157, freshman **Justin Bonitatis (Cherry Hill, NJ/Cherry Hill East)** coming out on top 24-8 at 165 and junior **Greg Osgoodby (Waldwick, NJ/Waldwick)** recording a 19-2 victory at 174.

The Lions return to the mat on Sunday, February 24 when they head to Wilkes University for the Metropolitan Conference Championships. The winners from each weight class plus seven "wild cards" will then advance to the 2008 NCAA Division III Championships in early March. TCNJ will enter the tournament as the defending champions.

Lion bites...

- The Lions have recorded back-to-back 19-win seasons and have recorded double figures in victories every year since 1986-87.
- TCNJ is ranked 20th in the latest NWCA Brute - Adidas Division III poll with two grapplers ranked in their respective weight classes. Osgoodby is ranked fifth at 174 pounds and has a record of 29-4 this season, while Sarinelli is ninth at 133 pounds. He is 25-4 on the year.
- Osgoodby is the lone Metropolitan Conference cham-

pion returning for the Lions with Sarinelli and Carbone looking to improve on their second-place finishes a year ago.

- Bonitatis leads the team in victories with a mark of 31-4, with Osgoodby and Wonesh each one win away from joining the 30-win club. DiColo is also closing in on that milestone as he is 28-7 this season. Those 28 wins are also a career high.
- By picking up a win in the dual meet against Oswego State, Wonesh finished the season a team-best 16-1 in dual meets.
- Franke's win by fall, in the dual meet against Scranton, was his first pin as a Lion.
- The 2008 NCAA Division III Championships are set for March 7-8 at the U.S. Cellular Center in Cedar Rapids, IA. The event will be hosted by Coe College and the Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Association.

TCNJ caps regular season with sweep of Ramapo

The Lions made "Senior Night" a successful one as the men's and women's swimming and diving teams hosted Ramapo College in the final dual meet of the season. Both TCNJ squads came away with impressive wins as TCNJ's women's squad won 117-73 and the men posted a 103-69 victory.

Men's Recap...

Junior **Mike Molloy (Toms River, NJ/Toms River East)** added three first-place finishes at the meet. He took first in the 200 backstroke in 2:00.61, the 200 freestyle in 1:49.01, and the 100 free in 48.83.

TCNJ added a first in the 200 medley relay in 1:40.15 and the 200 free relay in 1:28.54. Swimming on the winning medley relay for the Lions were freshman **Joe Tseng (East Hanover, NJ/Hanover Park)**, junior **Ted Yoa (Ocean City, NJ/St. Augustine)**, sophomore **Herman Chu (Long Valley, NJ/West Morris Central)**, and senior **Jonaid Lone (Leonia, NJ/Don Bosco Prep)**. Combining on the free relay were senior **Josh Forsman (Jackson, NJ/Jackson Memorial)**, senior **Liam Gallagher (Bridgewater, NJ/Bridgewater-Raritan)**, Lone, and senior **Kevin Oliver (Toms River, NJ/Toms River North)**.

Junior **Thomas Nawrot (East Brunswick, NJ/East Brunswick)** won the 1,000 free in 10:56.89 and the 50

freestyle in 21.84. Senior **John Altobelli (Northfield, NJ/Mainland Regional)** won the 100 back in 58.55, while sophomore **Eric Rohrs (Congers, NY/Clarkstown High North)** won the 100 breaststroke in 10:00.78 and the 200 breaststroke in 2:14.85.

Freshman **Tim Rauch (Hillsborough, NJ/Hillsborough)** added an impressive time in the 200 butterfly of 2:00.89, while freshman **Andrew Hessler (Palmyra, NJ/Palmyra)** was next in 2:04.57 and senior **R.T. Greeby (Hainesport, NJ/Rancocas Valley)** was third in 2:04.77 to help the Lions sweep the event.

Lone added a first for the Lions in the 500 free in 4:56.68, while Gallagher added a first in the 100 fly in 54.31. Forsman added a first in the 200 individual medley in 2:03.52 to help the Lions dominate the meet.

Women's Recap...

The Lions posted a sweep of the 200 medley relay, as they took first through fourth place in the event. Winning the race were the foursome of senior **Christine Marino (Scotch Plains, NJ/Mt. St. Mary's Academy)**, senior **Lauren Pfeifer (Freehold, NJ/Red Bank Catholic)**, senior **Ava Kiss (North Brunswick, NJ/Stuart Country Day)** and **Kristin Udicious (Cherry Hill, NJ/Gloucester Catholic)** in 1:55.17. The Lions also won the 200 free relay in 1:47.71 as Kiss, freshman **Jennifer Rashti (Cherry Hill, NJ/Cherry Hill West)**, senior **Meghan Moore (Randolph, NJ/Randolph)**, and Marino teamed up.

Rashti also took first in the 1,000 free in 11:22.33, while TCNJ's rookie **Margaret Molloy (Toms River, NJ/Toms River East)** won the 200 free in 1:57.43, while Kiss finished in second place in 1:59.00. Molloy won the 200 back in 2:19.54. Marino added a second in the 200 breast in 2:40.73 for the Lions.

TCNJ's junior **Emily Reichard (Voorhees, NJ/Eastern Regional)** won 100 back in 1:05.35, while Pfeifer added a second place showing in 1:06.79.

Junior **Brittany Collyer (Forked River, NJ/Lacey Township)** won the 100 breast in 1:13.01. The Lions added another first-place finish as freshman **Kristen Prentice (Skillman, NJ/Montgomery)** posted a time of 2:21.41, while junior **Sara Casciano (Hewitt, NJ/Immaculate Heart Academy)** took second in 2:28.39 in the 200 fly.

Udicious won the 50 free in 26.13, while sophomore **Stephanie Seto (Hamilton, NJ/Steinert)** picked up second in 26.19. Seto also won the 200 IM in 2:17.39, while freshman **Katie Zavoda (East Brunswick, NJ/East Brunswick)** was the winner of the 100 free race with her time of 56.02. Senior **Caitlin Elmendorf (Medford, NJ/Shawnee)** won the 100 fly in 1:04.85.
