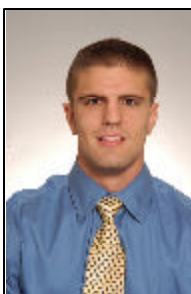


### FEMALE LION OF THE WEEK

## TCNJ advances to second round of NCAAs

TCNJ saw its season come to a close in the second round of the 2008 NCAA Division III Tournament as the Lions fell at fourth-ranked University of Mary Washington by the score of 56-50.

The Lions held a six-point advantage in the early stages of the second half, but the host Eagles put together a 19-3 run to take a 40-30 lead and never relinquished that lead.

TCNJ finished its successful season with a record of 22-7, the most victories by the Lions since the 2000-01 season, when they had 25.

The Eagles held a decisive advantage from the foul line in the game making 23-of-38 attempts, while the Lions made only six of their 15 shots from the stripe.

It was a game of runs as well in the first half as the Lions opened the scoring as senior **Sara Best (High Bridge, NJ/Voorhees)** knocked down a jump shot, but the Eagles stormed back scoring the next 10 points for a 10-2 lead.

TCNJ came right back with the 7-0 spurt making it a one-point game before regaining the lead at 16-15 on a shot by sophomore **Alexandra Gregorek (Mahwah, NJ/Academy of Holy Angels)**. The teams remained close until the break when the Lions went into the intermission holding a 23-19 advantage. TCNJ's defense held Mary Washington scoreless for the final 5:39 of the half.

Gregorek led the Lions with 12 points and added six rebounds, while Best chipped in with 11 points. Junior **Hillary Klimowicz (Scotch Plains, NJ/Scotch Plains-Fanwood)** was held to single digits for only the second time this season finishing with eight points and seven rebounds. Freshman **Kelsey Kutch (Hillsborough, NJ/Hillsborough)** chipped in with seven points and seven rebounds.

The Lions opened the tournament facing Bridgewater (VA) State and earned a 65-52 win.

TCNJ led from the start scoring the game's first seven points and led by as many as 12 on several occasions. The Lions did a lot of their damage from behind the 3-point arc as junior **Alyssa Michella (Washington Twp., NJ/Immaculate Heart Academy)** connected three times from long range as TCNJ carried a 31-23 advantage into the half.

In the second half, the Lions built the lead to 43-27, but the Eagles closed the margin to 48-41 with 8:32 remaining. That was as close as Bridgewater would get, as TCNJ responded with a quick 5-0 run to regain control en route to the victory.

Best poured in a career high 19 points for the Lions, shooting 8-for-11 from the floor. She also added eight rebounds. Klimowicz contributed with 16 points, eight rebounds and five blocked shots, while Michella was the third Lion to reach double figures with 11. Kutch added to the win with eight points and 10 rebounds.

## *Lion Bites...*

- Klimowicz was named as a finalist for All-America honors, while head coach Dawn Henderson was tabbed as the regional coach of the year.

Klimowicz was one of five players from Region 3 named to the ballot for the 2008 State Farm Coaches' All-America Basketball Team for the Women's Coaches Basketball Coaches Association for Division III. There are eight different regions and the 40 finalists, who are voted upon by WBCA member coaches in each of the eight WBCA award regions, are now in the running for selection to the 10-member State Farm Coaches' All-America Team.

The State Farm Coaches' All-America Basketball Team will be announced at the NCAA Division III Women's Basketball Banquet on Thursday, March 20, at Hope College in Holland, Michigan.

Henderson was tabbed as 2008 Russell Athletic/WBCA Region 3 Coach of the Year after guiding the Lions to a 22-7 season.

- Klimowicz finished second in the NJAC in scoring and third in rebounding. She led the team in both categories scoring at a clip of 17.3 points per game and grabbing 11.3 rebounds. She also topped the conference in field-goal percentage at 64.4% (206-for-320) and blocked shots (119). The junior was also named CoSIDA's *ESPN The Magazine* Academic All-America All-District II Third Team.

- The Lions are now 11-11 all-time in NCAA Tournament play in 11 appearances. Mary Washington (28-2) has now won consecutive games over TCNJ in the tournament, also ending the team's season in 2006.

## Herrick and Tricocci earn All-American honors

TCNJ's **Stephanie Herrick (Wayne, NJ/Wayne Valley)** finished seventh in a pair of events at the 2008 NCAA Division III Indoor Track & Field Championships earning her of All-American honors.

The Lion junior claimed seventh in the one-mile run as she posted a time of 5:05.20 and then finished in that same spot in the 800 meters with a time of 2:17.46. By placing in the top eight of each event, Herrick was also named an All-American in both events by the United States Track & Field and Cross Country Coaches Association. It marks the second straight year she has accomplished that feat in the 800 meters. She is also a two-time All-American in that event during the outdoor season.

Junior **Kristen Tricocci (Cinnaminson, NJ/Cinnaminson)**, placed fourth in the long jump on the opening day of competition, to be named an All-American.

Also at the national event, junior **Martine McGrath (West Long Branch, NJ/Shore Regional)** competed in the 5,000 meters and placed 12th with a time of 18:22.73.

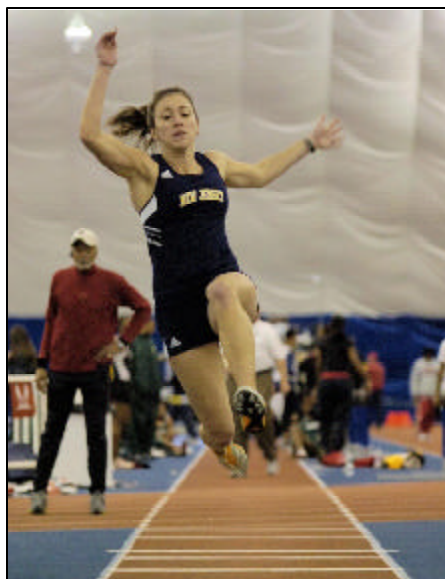
TCNJ's distance medley relay team finished 10th with a time of 12:29.86. Freshman **Meryl Wimberly (Farmingdale, NJ/Colts Neck)** ran the 1,200 meter portion of the race with classmate **Rochelle Prevard (Sicklerville, NJ/Winslow Township)** running the 400, sophomore **Jianna Spadaccini (Butler, NJ/Butler)** the

800 and McGrath handling the mile.

TCNJ finished 24th in the team standings collecting nine points.

## *Herrick receives national honor...*

- Herrick was named as the 2008 United States Track & Field and Cross Country Coaches Association Track Athlete of the Year. She is the first Lion to earn the award since the USTFCCA started presenting it. She has earned various honors this season including being named USTFCCA Division III Atlantic Region Indoor Track Athlete of the Year. She was previously selected as the Gerrity Award recipient as the most outstanding female athlete, as the Lions won their 11th consecutive New Jersey Athletic Conference Championships. Herrick was a five-time honoree as the NJAC Track Athlete of the Week and was tabbed the ECAC Division III Track Athlete on two occasions.

# WRESTLING

## Osgoodby and Bonitatis tabbed All-Americans

The long list of All-American wrestlers at The College of New Jersey grew by two at the NCAA Division III Championships as junior **Greg Osgoodby (Waldwick, NJ/Waldwick)** and freshman **Justin Bonitatis (Cherry Hill, NJ/Cherry Hill East)** each earned that distinction by placing in the top eight of their respective weight classes at the 2008 NCAA Division III Championships.

Osgoodby placed seventh at 174 pounds, while Bonitatis finished eighth at 165. The two Lions increased the program's overall number of All-Americans to 138.

Osgoodby opened the tournament with a 10-3 loss to Brandon MacWhinnie from Stevens Institute of Technology and then reeled off two wins in the consolation bracket winning by fall in 2:44 over Augsburg's George Lynaugh and then beating Ithaca College's Dave Priest, 11-6. He then fell Kyle Kehrl from Cornell College by the score of 6-1 and capped the tournament on a winning note as he defeated eighth-seeded Jerome Owens from Johnson & Wales University, 13-7 to claim seventh place.

Bonitatis got off to a great start by knocking off fifth-seeded Shaheim Bradshaw of SUNY Brockport, 5-4, but came up a point short against another seeded opponent falling 8-7 to Benjamin Hoover from Maranatha Baptist.

Bonitatis then moved to the consolation bracket where he doubled up Patrick Stanley from Johns Hopkins by the score of 10-5. In his next match, he lost to third-seeded Gino Russo from Baldwin Wallace, 12-10. He then

faced Wartburg's Justin Hanson in the seventh-place bout and fell by the count of 12-7.

Both Osgoodby and Bonitatis finished the season with identical 36-7 records.

Senior **Ray Sarinelli (Rockaway, NJ/Morris Hills)** opened the tournament at 133 with a 6-2 decision over Luther College's Zac Bartlett, but then fell to David Morgan from King's College, 9-3. Morgan is the defending national champion and seeded second in the weight class. The loss dropped Sarinelli, the seventh seed, into the consolation bracket where he fell to eighth-seeded Jestin Hulegaard of Buena Vista, 7-4.

Sarinelli finished the season with a record 28-7

and concluded his standout career at TCNJ at 90-28 and a two-time NCAA qualifier.

Freshman **John Barnett (Oak Ridge, NJ/Jefferson Township)** dropped both of his matches at 149 falling to Jonathan Quist from Luther College by the score of 4-2 in his opening contest. Barnett then fell in the consolation bracket by the score of 10-2 to eighth-seeded Aaron Cook from Buena Vista. He finished the season with a record of 26-11.

The Lions placed 24th as a team and maintained their impressive streak of finishing in the top 25 at the national tournament each year since it began in 1974.

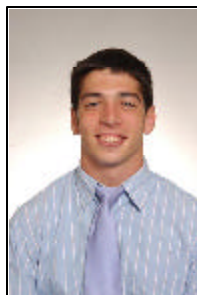
## *Osgoodby honored for academics...*

## Ava Kiss crowned 2008 National Champion

Senior **Ava Kiss (North Brunswick, NJ/Stuart Country Day)** competed for the Lions in the 100 butterfly event and posted the second fastest time in the morning trials as she had a time of 56.05, standing second behind Denison University's Olivia Zaleski who had a 55.50 in the trials. In the finals, Kiss exceeded her trial effort as she not only won the 2008 NCAA Division III Championship in the race, but set both a TCNJ and a national Division III record in the process with her time of 55.08. She surpassed the old mark held by Mollie Parrish of Denison University set in 2002 that had stood at 55.16.

Kiss is now a four-time All-American having previously finished ninth in this event in 2005 and 2007 and fourth in 2006. She becomes TCNJ's first NCAA Division III Women's Swimming National titlist, as the only other Lion to have won an NCAA crown at the Division III Swimming and Diving Championship was Diane Maiese, winner the one-meter diving championship in 1997.

Kiss said of her national championship title, "I am feeling pretty numb at this point. It really has not sunk in for me." Kiss added, "I am so very proud to be the first TCNJ women's swimmer to win a national championship. I have worked for this my entire career at TCNJ and to have this happen is just a dream come true."

TCNJ's senior **Lauren Pfeifer (Freehold, NJ/Red Bank Catholic)** competed in the 100 breaststroke and finished in 21st place with her time of 1:07.25, but did not advance to the evening finals of the event.

Pfeifer opened competition as she swam in the 50 freestyle event. She would record a personal best time of 24.97, but finished in 40th place and did not advance to the evening finals of the event.

Kiss competed for the Lions in the 200 individual medley race and posted an impressive time of 2:10.42 to finish in 28th place, but did not advance to the finals.

On the final day of competition, Kiss and Pfeifer closed their stellar athletic careers as they competed for the Lions in the 100 freestyle race. In the morning trials of the event, Pfeifer posted a time of 54.51 to finish in 39th place and did not qualify for the finals. Kiss posted a time of 52.29 to advance to the consolation finals where she was seeded 12th.

In the finals, Kiss posted a time of 51.92 to earn 10th place and collect All-America Honorable Mention Honors. Kiss wraps her career as a five-time All-American.

Pfeifer wraps her career having competed at the NCAA championships for the first time during her career and has helped the Lions as she is part of the school's 200 medley relay record foursome and also holds the school mark in the 100 breaststroke (1:06.81).

The three-day championship event was held at the Corwin M. Nixon Aquatic Center on the campus of Miami University. Kenyon College collected the program's 22nd NCAA Division III Women's Swimming and Diving National crown after racking up 566.5 points. TCNJ's women's team finished in 33rd place with 27 points and had just two competitors contending at the event.

## Seven Lions invited to NCAA Championships

TCNJ will be well represented at the 2008 NCAA Division III Men's Swimming and Diving Championships with seven individuals slated to compete in a number of events.

The meet is slated for March 20-22 and will be held at the Corwin M. Nixon Aquatic Center on the campus of Miami University, while Wooster College is serving as the host institution.

Topping the list of Lions heading to the national championship is nine-time All-American **Josh Forsman (Jackson, NJ/Jackson Memorial)**. The senior earned a spot in the 100 butterfly with a qualifying mark of 49.90 seconds. He will also be swimming 100 freestyle as he boasted a time of 49.90 seconds.

Classmate **Liam Gallagher (Bridgewater, NJ/Bridgewater-Raritan)** qualified in the 200 individual medley with the fifth best time (1:52.78) leading up to the meet. Gallagher has already garnered six All-American citations. He will also be swimming in a pair of backstroke events, participating in the 100 and the 200-yard races with qualifying times of 52.13 and 1:53.89 respectively.

Junior **Tom Nawrot (East Brunswick, NJ/East Brunswick)** will swim in the 100 backstroke as he earned a spot by posting a time of 51.94 seconds. The Lion will also swim in two freestyle races qualifying in the 50 (20.90) and 100 free (46.00). He will also be looking to add to his impressive list of All-American honors as he already has four to his credit.

Junior diver **Greg Lloyd (Ringoes, NJ/Hunterdon Central)** will have a busy weekend competing in both the

one-meter and three-meter events. Each event will consist of 11 dives. Lloyd has experience on his side, as he has earned All-American status in each event and is making his third straight appearance at the NCAA Championships.

Sophomore **Myles O'Connor (Santa Monica, CA)** qualified for the second straight year and will compete in the 100 and 200 breaststroke. The two-time All-American qualified in the 100 with a time of 56.90 seconds and 2:06.82 in the 200.

Freshman **Tom Medvecky (Piscataway, NJ/Piscataway)** looks to add to his already impressive first season with the Lions as he qualified in three events. He will swim in the 200 free as he had a qualifying time of 1:42.76 in addition to the 500 free. Medvecky, who was earlier tabbed as the Metropolitan Conference Rookie of the Year, qualified for that event with a time of 4:35.68. His final event is the 200 fly (1:52.31).

TCNJ will be extremely busy during the relay events with five different teams taking the water. The Lions will swim in the 200, 400 and 800 free relays with the quartet of Nawrot, Gallagher, Forsman and freshman **Shawn Kircher (Toms River, NJ/Toms River North)** swimming the two shorter free relays and Gallagher, Medvecky, Kircher and Forsman in the 800 free.

The final two relays are the 200 and 400 medley relays, which head to the championships meet having boasted the third best time so far this season in each race. Nawrot, O'Connor and Forsman will swim the first three legs of the relay in each distance, with Kircher anchoring the 200 and Gallagher filling that same spot in the 400.
