Lions remain in the hunt for first place in NJAC

An up and down week for the Lions saw TCNJ's baseball team finish in a high note as the Lions swept William Paterson in conference play. TCNJ is in a three-way tie for first in the NJAC heading into the final week of conference play. TCNJ has NJAC contests remaining with Ramapo and a pair at Kean to complete the regular-season. Non-conference action has TCNJ hosting Stevens and traveling to Widener this week as well.

TCNJ's offense has been sparked by a number of players helping the squad combine for a .328 average while adding 97 extra-base hits, including 59 doubles.

Junior second baseman **Adam Tussey (Brooklawn, NJ/Gloucester)** has a .414 average with 58 hits, including 53 singles, while driving 27 runs for the Lions as a starter in all 31 games.

Junior shortstop **Jeff Toth (Parlin, NJ/Sayreville)** has a .392 average with 36 RBIs on 46 hits with six home runs. He has drawn 24 walks and is 11-13 on stolen bases with a .650 slugging percentage.

Senior **Bill Kropp (Pottstown, PA/Owen J. Roberts)** got his first career home run in his 117 games at TCNJ. He has a .367 average this season with 40 hits and 21 RBIs. On his career, Kropp has racked up a 3.926 GPA while adding a .314 career batting average with 119 hits, making him a candidate for the 2008 ESPN The Magazine Academic All-America Team.

Junior third baseman **Vince Mazzaccaro (Gloucester, NJ/Gloucester Catholic)** is batting .370 with a team-leading 37 RBIs and 13 extra-base hits. He has seven doubles, two triples and five home runs. With a .575 slugging percentage, he has also added five sacrifice flies and has started all 31 games.

Senior catcher **Rich Gawlak (Plainsboro, NJ/West Windsor-Plainsboro South)** has added to his career-best numbers that include 36 RBIs and a .323 average. A 31-game starter, he has committed just two errors in 270 total chances for a .993 fielding percentage.

Seniors **Dave Mebs (Cinnaminson, NJ/Cinnaminson)** and **Matt Barrett (Pennington, NJ/Hopewell Valley)** balance the Lions' outfield. Mebs, the

Lions' centerfielder, is batting .310 with 40 hits and 21 RBIs and leads the team with 41 runs scored. Barrett is batting .267 with three home runs in 19 games and has shared time in right field with senior **Tyler Hall (Stockton, NJ/Immaculata)**, who has started 16 of 21 games played. Rounding out the outfield is sophomore **Chris Esperon (Union, NJ/Union Catholic)**, who has made 30 starts and has a .261 average with a team-leading nine doubles and has driven in 20 runs.

Sophomore **Ryan Anzelone (Vernon, NJ/Vernon Township)** has a .308 batting average with two home runs and five doubles, while rookie **Matt Giermanski (Oradell, NJ/River Dell Regional)** has a .286 average in eight games played. Sophomore **Nick Tutrone (Marlboro, NJ/Marlboro)** and rookie **Elliot Stein (Middletown, DE/Middletown)** have also contributed as well for the Lions.

Senior pitcher **Mike Oliver (Crosswicks, NJ/Hamilton West)** is riding an unbeaten streak on the mound that stands at 10-0, as he is 5-0 again this year. Oliver has worked 49.2 innings and fanning 53 batters and has a 2.36 ERA in seven starts. He is 18-2 as a Lion with 157 career strikeouts to his credit.

Senior **Bob Buskett (Trenton, NJ/Notre Dame)** boasts a 5-1 record with a 3.8 ERA and 27 strikeouts in seven games. Buskett, who is also a candidate for the 2008 ESPN The Magazine Academic All-America Team has a 20-3 career record with a 3.54 ERA and 118 strikeouts.

Senior pitcher **Brad Kittle (Millville, NJ/Millville)** has appeared in four games this season after a delayed start with a pre-season injury. Kittle is 1-0 with a 0.0 ERA in 7.2 IP while adding nine strikeouts. On his career, he is 12-5 with 130 strikeouts.

Senior **Nick Amabile (Holmdel, NJ/Holmdel)** is 2-0 with a 3.67 ERA with 26 K's in 27 IP, while junior **Pat Johnson (Hamilton, NJ/Steinert)** added his first win as a Lion and has a 3.44 ERA and 15 K's in 18.1 innings. Junior **Eric Gertie (Cinnaminson, NJ/Cinnaminson)** has a 3-2 record with a team-leading six saves. He has appeared in 13 games with a 1.83 ERA and 28 K's in 19.2 IP.

TCNJ's junior pitcher **Dan Anderson (Lincroft, NJ/Middletown South)** has a 3-0 record on the mound with a 4.31 ERA in six starts. In 31.1 innings, he has racked up 18 strikeouts, while junior **Dan Ramos-Dominko (Hampton, NJ/North Hunterdon)** holds a 2-2 record on a 5.45 ERA with 35 strikeouts in 34.2 IP. Additional support from the pitching staff has come from **Connor Henderson (Monmouth Junction, NJ/South Brunswick)** who is 1-0 with a 3.75 ERA, while sophomore reliever **Greg Spatz (Oakhurst, NJ/Ocean Township)** has worked in four games and has a 4.91 ERA and seven strikeouts.

TCNJ eyes playoff spot; Miller earns 350th win

The Lions remained in the hunt for one of the New Jersey Athletic Conference's six playoff spots as they finished the week with an even record of 2-2.

The team currently sits in fifth place with a record of 8-6 with 16 points, two points behind Kean University and two points ahead of Richard Stockton College.

TCNJ opened the week with a doubleheader at 21st-ranked Rowan University and were swept by the Profs. Rowan won the first game, 6-0, and took the second game 11-2 in eight innings.

The Lions bounced back in exciting fashion with a sweep of New Jersey City University winning the opening game, 1-0, as sophomore **Ashley Minervini (Cliffside Park, NJ/Cliffside Park)** singled home the game's only run in the bottom of the seventh inning.

In the second game, sophomore **Danielle Hagel (Egg Harbor City, NJ/Oakcrest)** hit a two-out grand slam in the top of the seventh inning to break open a tie game, as the Lions finished off the Gothic Knights, 7-3.

That win was also the 350th for head coach Sally Miller in her 13 years at TCNJ. Miller's career mark stands at an impressive 350-157-2 for a .690 winning percentage.

Against Rowan, the Profs grabbed the early lead scoring single runs in each of the first three innings and added three more in the sixth to win the opening game. In the second game, sophomore **Ellen Seavers (Ridgewood, NJ/Ridgewood)** and junior **Camille Heller (Maple Shade, NJ/Maple Shade)** each drove in runs as the teams were tied at the end of seven innings. Rowan took advantage of that extra inning to pull out the win.

In addition to getting the game-winning hit in the first game against NJCU, Minervini fired a one-hit shutout.

Minervini and sophomore **Rachel Greeby (Yardleey, PA/Pennsbury)** each had two hits in the win.

Hagel assured the Lions of the sweep in the second game with her third home run of the season. She also drove in five of the team's seven runs.

Minervini pitched the final 1.1 innings to pick up her second win of the day.

The Lions wrap up the regular season this week with two games at Rutgers-Newark on Tuesday before returning home on Saturday to face William Paterson University. Saturday will also be "Senior Day" as the team's two seniors, **Christina Lizzi (Wyckoff, NJ/Ramapo)** and **Lauren Musacchia (Wesfield, NJ/Westfield)**, will be honored prior to the first game.

Lion Bites....

- Heller had a solid week at the plate batting .400 with a pair of doubles.
- Minervini has been the anchor of the pitching staff leading the team in appearances (24), innings pitched (116.1) and strikeouts (89). She has already set a career high with 11 victories.
- At the plate, Seavers leads the team with a .357 average, but has also put up good power numbers with eight doubles and four home runs. She has recorded 13 multiple-hit games and has hit safely in 28 of her 33 games played.
- Seavers and Hagel are both candidates for the 2008 ESPN The Magazine Academic All-America Team.

TCNJ collects two more victories

The Lions picked up a pair of wins last week scoring an 18-9 victory at Cabrini College before holding off sixth-ranked Washington & Lee University, 12-8.

In the win over Cabrini, the Cavaliers challenged the Lions early leading on three separate occasions with their final lead coming at 5-4. TCNJ then ripped off six straight to grab the lead and eventually led 12-6 at the half.

TCNJ then outscored the hosts 6-3 in the final 30 minutes to secure the win. Senior **Karen Doane (Bridgewater, NJ/Bridgewater-Raritan)** led the offense with six goals, while freshman **Alison Jaeger (Hampton,**

NJ/North Hunterdon) added four goals and sophomore **Angela Wilmer (Cherry Hill, NJ/Cherry Hill West)** and freshman **Leigh Mitchell (Mt. Laurel, NJ/Lenape)** each finished with three goals.

Senior **Caitlin Gregory (Winslow, NJ/Eastern)** collected six saves to pick up the victory.

In the showdown with Washington & Lee, the teams were deadlocked at seven goals apiece at the half, but the Lions took control in the second half limiting the Generals to only one goal, while scoring four times.

Doane once again led the offense, this time scoring five goals. Senior **Diane Haddeland (Mahopac, NY/Mahopac)** added two goals in the victory with five other players contributing one.

Gregory again earned the win in goal making four saves.

TCNJ has another busy week ahead starting with a contest at Montclair State University on Tuesday. The Lions will then play their final home game against Rowan University at TCNJ's Soccer Complex in a 5 p.m. start. Prior to that game, TCNJ will honor its five seniors for their dedication to the program. The week comes to an end as the Lions head to Frostburg State University on Saturday.

Lion Bites...

- The win over the Generals stopped their 11-game winning streak, as they had not lost since March 9 to Franklin & Marshall.
- Doane finished with 11 goals last week and has 50 on the season marking the second time in her career she has hit that milestone. She has also moved into eighth place on the program's all-time goal list with 180 and is eighth in points with 225, two behind **Repy Hattersley (1979-82)**.
- Senior **Toni-Anne Cavallo (Cedar Grove, NJ/West Essex)** is closing in on 100 career goals as she has tallied 91 times in 58 games in a TCNJ uniform.
- Jaeger has emerged as a big scoring threat for the Lions this season as she leads the team in assists (14) and is second in goals (31) and points (45).
- Junior **Katie Reuther (Toms River, NJ/Toms River North)** continued to contribute in a host of areas with nine goals, 29 ground balls, 32 draw controls and 14 caused turnovers.
- TCNJ has dominated the opposition in the first half this season, outscoring them by a margin of 117-40.
- The Lions are 4-1 against ranked opponents this season.

Lion women shuts out Bates; men await NCAA bid

TCNJ's women's tennis team took to the courts last week just once, but came away with a convincing 9-0 victory over Bates College in a regional match. TCNJ's women's team, which is ranked 26th nationally, stands at 11-6 on the season. The Lions have now beaten seven of their opponents by a score of 9-0 this year, while going 10-2 against regional opponents.

TCNJ's women's team will close the regular-season on Tuesday, April 22 when Swarthmore College visits campus. The Lions will honor their seniors in the final home match of the year. They are **Christina Contrafatto (Cherry Hill, NJ/Cherry Hill West)**, **Kimberly Lee Lum (Princeton Junction, NJ/West Windsor-Plainsboro South)** and **Ariel Donohue (Highland Mills, NY/Cornwall Central)**.

TCNJ's men's team went 0-2 last week, dropping two matches to nationally ranked opponents, Bates (5-4) and Middlebury (8-1). The men's team has competed the regular-season and has a 9-5 record. TCNJ ranks 14 nationally and fifth in the latest regional poll.

Women's Highlights...

The women's team rebounded from a tough loss to nationally ranked Mary Washington by beating Bates 9-0. TCNJ is 11-6 on the year and holds a No. 8 regional ranking and is No. 26 nationally in the latest ITA poll.

TCNJ's women's coach **Scott Dicheck** is closing in on his 100th career win. Dicheck stands at 97-29 in his eighth season with the team.

Sophomore **Jackie Shtemberg (Franklin Lakes, NJ/Ramapo)** added two wins on the week as she was a winner at first singles and doubles against the Bobcats. She leads TCNJ with her 23-8 singles record, while adding an 11-5 dual meet record. The 2007 ITA All-American, is closing in on 100 wins as well, as she is 95-27 on her career and is ranked first regionally in singles action. She has teamed at first doubles with Contrafatto. The pair stands at 21-9 on the season with a 12-4 mark in dual action and ranks third regionally. Contrafatto plays at third singles and is 16-9 this year and is ranked 19th regionally. She holds a combined 138-53 record at TCNJ.

Rookie **Amanda Berg (Mendham, NJ/West Morris-Mendham)** is 14-12 in singles play with an 8-8 dual meet record, playing at second and third singles.

Sophomore **Stefanie Haar (Morganville, NJ/Marlboro)** boasts a 16-8 overall singles record this year playing at fourth singles. She leads the Lions with her 12 dual meet victories and is 12-4 on the year. Haar has teamed with two partners this year and is 21-5 overall in doubles action. This spring, she has enjoyed success at

second doubles with junior **Haley Kutner (Franklin Lakes, NJ/Dwight Englewood)** to go 9-4. Kutner is 7-5 on the season in singles action.

Junior **Lindsay Katzel (Boyd's, MD/Quince Orchard)** is 7-4 in singles play, while sophomore **Sarah Roser (Bernardsville, NJ/Bernards)** is 11-8 in singles action.

Men's Highlights...

TCNJ's men's team must now wait for the announcement of the 2008 NCAA Championship field on April 28 with regional play commencing on May 2-4. The Lions tallied key regional and national wins this spring, having beaten four nationally ranked opponents this year. TCNJ is ranked 14th nationally and No. 5 regionally.

Senior tri-captains **Mike Klimchak (Clark, NJ/Arthur L. Johnson)** and **Roger Mosteller (Medford Lakes, NJ/Shawnee)** capped the week with a 8-6 win over the region's top ranked doubles pair as they tallied a win at Middlebury College. The Lion duo is ranked third regionally and has compiled a record of 11-4. The pair earned an NCAA Division III Doubles Championship appearance last season and is looking to return to the event. Since teaming with one another, the Lions' top doubles tandem is 44-12.

Klimchak, who also plays first singles, is 16-9 on the season with an 8-5 dual-meet record. Mosteller has added an 11-3 record at fourth singles play and has racked up a career record of 75-17, while Klimchak, an ITA All-American in the fall of 2007, is 139-42 on his TCNJ career. Klimchak is currently ranked sixth regionally in singles play. Senior tri-captain **Eric Ferriere (Montague, NJ/Kittantiny)** is ranked 19th regionally. Ferriere is 12-10 on the year in singles play. Overall on his career, he is 115-42 at TCNJ. Sophomore **Jeremy Eckardt (Belle Mead, NJ/Montgomery)** is 10-3 at third singles and 14-6 on the year in singles play, while the pair has teamed at second doubles to go 11-4.

Newcomer **Jonathan Yu (Hamilton, NJ/Steinert)** has played at fifth and sixth singles and is 9-11, while sophomore **Jon Glinzman (North Brunswick, NJ/North Brunswick)** is 3-4 overall, with a 3-1 record at sixth singles in dual action. Yu has teamed at third doubles with junior **James Vance (Yardley, PA/Pennsbury East)** and the Lion duo is 5-4. overall with a 5-2 dual record together.

TCNJ excels at Larry Ellis and Greyhound invites

A busy schedule couldn't slow The College of New Jersey men's and women's outdoor track and field teams as the Lions boasted plenty of post-season worthy efforts at a pair of invitationals this weekend.

The Lions started by competing at the Larry Ellis Invitational hosted by Princeton University and also excelled at the Greyhound Invitational hosted by Moravian College.

This weekend, TCNJ will compete on its home track for the second time this season, hosting the Lions' Invitational.

Larry Ellis Invitational...

TCNJ was well represented at the Larry Ellis Invitational hosted by Princeton University with the Lions shining in the women's 800 meters. Junior **Stephanie Herrick (Wayne, NJ/Wayne Valley)** finished third in the race with an automatic NCAA time of 2:10.44 and teammate **Jianna Spadaccini (Butler, NJ/Butler)** was 14th with a NCAA provisional time of 2:14.75. Freshman **Meryl Wimberly (Farmingdale, NJ/Colts Neck)** added to the strong showing in the event taking 20th in the large field with an ECAC worthy time of 2:15.75.

Junior **Martine McGrath (West Long Branch, NJ/Shore Regional)** added a fifth-place finish in the 5,000 meters with an ECAC time of 17:55.06.

The men had a pair of runners qualify for the ECAC Championships. Junior **Pasquale DiGiacchino (Bernardsville, NJ/Bernards)** had a time of 1:54.92 in the 800 meters, while **Galen Johnson (South Plainfield, NJ/South Plainfield)** posted a time of 9:38.27 in the 3,000 steeplechase.

Greyhound Invitational...

The Lion women added two more NCAA provisional marks as **Jessica Bonelli (Sewell, NJ/Gloucester Catholic)** won the 200 with a time of 25.16 seconds. She was also part of the 4x100 relay that boasted a NCAA provisional cut of 48.64 seconds as she was joined on the team by Wimberly, **Priscilla Senyah (Sayreville, NJ/Sayreville War Memorial)** and **Kristen Tricocci (Cinnaminson, NJ/Cinnaminson)**.

Bonelli added a fifth-place effort in the 100 meters with an ECAC cut of 12.59 seconds.

Sophomore **Michelle Wallace (Emerson, NJ/Emerson)** won the 3,000 steeplechase with an ECAC worthy time of 11:56.27.

TCNJ had a strong showing in the 400 meters as three runners each placed in the top 20 earning ECAC marks. Spadaccini finished with a time of 58.32 seconds followed by Wimberly in 59.08 and freshman **Alexandra Tomaselli (Hillsdale, NJ/Pascack Valley)** in 60.09.

Junior **Justine Carnevale (Oceanport, NJ/Shore Regional)** was fifth in the 1,500 with a personal-best time of 4:59.08, while **Meghan Miller (Sayreville, NJ/Sayreville War Memorial)** was sixth in the 400 hurdles with an ECAC time of 66.09.

For the men, freshman **Dennie Waite (Little Silver, NJ/Red Bank Regional)** won the 1,500 meters with a personal-best time of 3:38.34 that not only was an ECAC qualifying mark, but a meet record as well.

Freshman **TJ Bocchino (Toms River, NJ/Toms River East)** crossed the finish line in third place in the 3,000 steeplechase with an ECAC time of 9:52.96, while senior **Andy Lim (Lodi, NJ/Leonia)** earned two ECAC distances in the jumping events. He was sixth in the triple jump at 13.18 meters and was ninth in the long jump at 6.56.

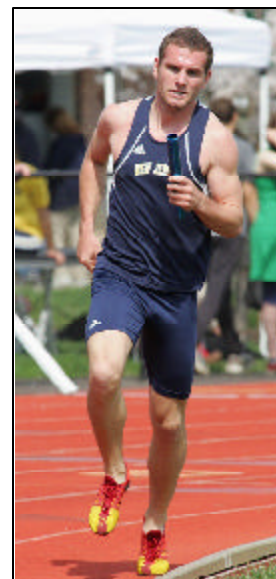
In the hurdles, **Kyle Gilroy (Oak Ridge, NJ/West Milford Twp.)** earned two top-10 finishes taking sixth in the 110 high hurdles (15.21) and ninth in the 400 hurdles (55.92). Both of those times met ECAC standards.

Senior **Josh Krowicki (Hilltop, NJ/Triton)** claimed fifth place in the 800 meters win 1:57.77, while freshman **Tim Blashford (Wykoff, NJ/Ramapo)** was ninth in the pole vault clearing 14.3 meters.

Freshman **Jule Brooks (Atlantic City, NJ/Atlantic City)** had a strong meet taking 12th in the 400 meters with an ECAC time of 50.34 seconds and added a 14th-place performance in the 200 (22.85).

Also in the 400, junior **Woodrow Prevard (Sicklerville, NJ/Winslow Twp.)** added a top-20 finish with a clocking of 50.88, just missing an ECAC cut.

Sophomore **Steve Licchetto (Barrington, NJ/Haddon Heights)** had a personal-best effort in the hammer throw with a distance of 41.82 meters.
